

# Route 101/Donovan Road Interchange

Completed: July 2002

**This project included the replacement of the Donovan Road overcrossing, modifications to ramps, construction of a new southbound ramp to Route 101 and local street improvements. The new overcrossing is both longer, to accommodate future widening of Route 101 to six-lanes and wider with 5 lanes of traffic.**

**PHOTO 1:** The new overcrossing of Route 101 at Donovan Road replaced a two-lane structure that presented operational and geometric deficiencies. The new overcrossing improves traffic operations and provides safe travel for pedestrians and bicyclists. The structures were anchored by the construction of pilasters in each quadrant of the bridge depicting the Santa Maria logo.



**PHOTO 2:** One key feature of this project included the construction of a new southbound on-ramp to Route 101. The new ramp accommodates eastbound traffic on Donovan Road. Westbound traffic will continue to use the existing southbound on-ramp on the north side of Donovan Road.
