This letter serves as notification to Caltrans and FHWA of the SBCAG 2009 FTIP Administrative Amendment #10. Pursuant to the authority delegated under the 2009 SBCAG FTIP, minor modifications to the 2009 FTIP will normally be handled as Administrative Amendments and may be approved at the discretion of the SBCAG Executive Director. I have given my approval to this amendment that makes the following changes to the project described below which is consistent with the requirements in 23 CFR 450:

- **SHOPP Lump Sum – Collision Reduction** – (MPO ID: SHOPP2): Remove Cold Springs Canyon Bridge Suicide Barrier Project from SHOPP Collision Reduction Lump Sum. Fiscal impact is the removal of \$3.256 million from the SHOPP Collision Reduction Lump Sum.
- **Economic Stimulus Projects Lump Sum – Streets and Roads Projects** – (MPO ID: VAR05): Replace the Milpas to Hot Springs Project with the Cold Springs Canyon Bridge Suicide Barrier Project in the ARRA back-up list. No change in funding.

The 2009 FTIP remains financially constrained.
