## PUBLIC WORKSHOPS & EIR SCOPING MEETINGS

**Come share your thoughts about the future of transportation and land use in Santa Barbara County!**

The Santa Barbara County Association of Governments (SBCAG) is updating the Regional Transportation Plan (RTP). The RTP plans how the region will invest in the transportation system over the next 20+ years. New with this update, the RTP also includes a Sustainable Communities Strategy (SCS).

With your input, SBCAG must select a **preferred future scenario** for the SCS from a range of transportation and land use alternatives. The scenario selected must meet a target for regional greenhouse gas emissions from passenger vehicles and strive to achieve other goals, including optimizing mobility, protecting the environment, assuring equity, improving public health and safety, and fostering a prosperous economy.

SBCAG is also soliciting input on the scope and content of the environmental analysis that will be included in the Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the RTP-SCS. SBCAG has prepared a separate Notice of Preparation of the EIR for circulation.
