This letter serves as notification to Caltrans and the FHWA of Administrative Amendment #7 to SBCAG's 2023 FTIP. Pursuant to the authority delegated by Caltrans, minor modifications to the 2023 FTIP will normally be handled as administrative modifications and may be approved at the discretion of the SBCAG Executive Director. I have given my approval to this administrative modification that makes the following changes to the projects described below which is consistent with the requirements in 23 CFR 450:

Administrative Amendment No. 7 to the 2023 FTIP will program the following changes: Grouped listing:

<u>Grouped Projects for Safety Improvement – HSIP (MPO ID: LOCALHSIP)</u>: This listing includes Cycle 11 projects that are federalized as noted on the DLA website and shows state-funded projects for information only. This amendment corrects the project description for one project in the group listing, adds Federal project No.'s and updates the implementing agency name on one project in the state funded project list. Project funding remains the same.

The 2023 FTIP remains financially constrained, meets air quality conformity, and does not interfere with the timely implementation of Transportation Control Measures contained in the State Implementation Plan.
