1 SBCAG	Santa Ynez Valley Trail	ATP funds will be used to advance trail design. As the planning study progresses, a segment fitting the budget will be identified to proceed through final design. Existing funding sources only allow final design of the segment within the City of Buellton leaving a budget gap for the other segments. The trail will extend between western Buellton and Highway 154 running east - west.	Infrastructure	\$ 572,000
2 County of Santa Barbara	Orcutt Creek Okerblom Trail	The 7-mile Orcutt Creek Okerblom Trail is the highest priority trail/bike path project in Orcutt as identified in the Orcutt Community Plan. It is also identified in the County Active Transportation Plan and County Parks, Recreation and Trails Map. ATP funds will be used to identify a preferred alignment and advance trail design. The design effort will build upon a general concept alignment review recently completed by County Parks. The work will aid County Parks in applying for statewide ATP grant funds in 2028 to advance engineering, environmental review, and secure construction funding.	Infrastructure	\$ 300,000
